

Greetings:

Faith Partnerships invites you to join us in Wilmington, North Carolina on November 1 and 2, 2011 for our Tenth Anniversary Celebration. Clergy and lay leaders will participate in our Faith Partnerships Leadership Conference: "From Generation to Generation." The conference will offer workshops and seminars that explore ways to engage the Community of Aging as Spiritual Agents for Change: Maximizing the Moment and Forging the Change in Missions,

Faith leaders will assemble to share strategies that engage clergy and congregations in social action to develop and sustain a new aging movement inclusive of the needs of vulnerable older adults. Key sessions will strengthen the ability of congregations and organizations that serve older adults to advocate and to mobilize their constituents.

We will revisit the capacity building Faith With Works efforts of the past, including grant writing and fiscal accountability, assess our recent work in the field of faith and social justice, including a review of key public policy issues and our role in disaster assistance from Hurricanes Irene to Floyd, Katrina, Rita and Wilma. We will provide education on specific issues critical to aging, e.g. health and economic security. The needs in our communities are growing. We remind the faith community of its calling to respond to such needs. This conference will offer clergy, directors of faith-based organizations, lay leadership, foundation program officers, corporate leaders, and representatives of government a comprehensive means of exploring new ways to become effective agents for change. Conference tracks include:

• **Advocacy and Action:**

Training and technical assistance will be provided to clergy and other leaders to become more effective teachers as they engage their congregations in identifying key aging issues and developing action plans. Significant activities will include organizing and advocating for institutional engagement in aging issues; building and leveraging alliances with groups with a track record of effective work with vulnerable populations; and, positioning leaders to assume state and national leadership roles;

• **Faith Demonstration Awards (Small Grants Program):**

Approximately 10- 15 organizations (grouped in state clusters) will receive small grants to assist in implementing promising action projects around aging issues in their communities;

• **Intergenerational Collaboration:**

In order to build an expanded base of support, FPI will educate and engage young leaders and clergy on aging issues, encouraging collective actions to promote continued support in improving the lives of elders – and of children and families.
